ISSUE:

A resolution approving a cooperative agreement between West Valley City and the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) to share the cost of sidewalk construction on 3500 South from 6755 West to 6800 West.

SYNOPSIS:

This agreement will enable West Valley City to receive funds from the State of Utah to construct a pedestrian safety project on 3500 South near 6800 West.

BACKGROUND:

The West Valley City Public Works Department applied for and received Safe Sidewalk Funds from the State of Utah for new sidewalk construction near 6800 West on 3500 South. The Safe Sidewalks Program provides a legislative funding source for construction of new sidewalks adjacent to State highways where sidewalks do not currently exist and where major construction or reconstruction of the route, at that location, is not planned for ten or more years.

State funds allocated to the project will total \$63,375, with a 25% local match of \$21,125, for a total cost of \$84,500.

This project is on a school walking route for Orchard Elementary and will shorten a gap of missing sidewalk and provide continuous sidewalk access to a bus stop from the east.

City staff recommends approval of the resolution.
