ISSUE:

Award Contract for the Riter Canal Detention Structure Project

SYNOPSIS:

Lowest responsible bid was received by FX Construction for the amount of \$192,000.00.

BACKGROUND:

Bids were opened for the project on February 17, 2015. A total of twelve (12) bids were received.

A substantial portion of the west end of the city drains to the Riter Canal, a channel which conveys process water to Kennecott, and is a Salt Lake County maintained flood control facility. In order to address the impact of a developing city, property has been acquired onto which flood waters may be attenuated during storm events. This contract will provide for the construction of the canal control structure designed to restrict the canal outflow to an allowed amount. This structure minimizes downstream flooding potential, and was required by Kennecott and Salt Lake County Flood Control in order to obtain permits to continue to increase runoff into the canal from new developments.

Funds are available in the FY14-15 Budget, and no budget opening is necessary.

RECOMMENDATION:

Award the contract to FX Construction in the amount of \$192,000, and authorize the Public Works Department to spend no more than \$211,000 in potential change orders.
